Total number of children and adolescents treated in 2019: 9

Average age of children and adolescents treated in 2019: 16 years

Average length of stay for children and adolescents treated on our Rehab Unit in 2019: 17 days

Program facts

- 56% of our children and adolescent population were discharged home in 2019, once they achieved their established goals.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with mobility, dressing, grooming, speech, language and mental skills.
- Our rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating children and adolescents patients with a variety of medical and traumatic injuries.
- It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 44% of our children and adolescent population transferred to the pediatric floor in 2019 for further treatment.
- The overall patient satisfaction for 2019 was in the top 10 percent of the nation.
