## Inpatient Rehabilitation Fact Sheet 2019

### Diagnosis: General Medicine

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Our program typically treats patients with debility resulting from:

- Impaired pulmonary function
- Pain syndromes
- Generalized weakness

**Total number of patients with a general medical condition treated in 2019: 117**

**Average age of patients with a general medical condition treated in 2019: 73 years**

**Average length of stay for patients with a general medical condition treated on our Rehab Unit in 2019: 12 days**

#### Program facts

- 68% of our patients with brain injuries in 2019, returned home once they have achieved their established goals.
- 7% of our patients with brain injuries in 2019, were discharged to a skilled nursing facility.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with mobility, dressing, grooming, speech, language and mental skills.
- Our rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating patients with a general medical condition as we serve more disabled and medically complex patients than those served in other facilities in the region and nation.
- It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 25% of our patients with general medical diagnosis transferred to a medical floor in 2019.
- The overall patient satisfaction for 2019 was in the top 10 percent of the nation. Our patient satisfaction for patient with general medical diagnosis was 91% in 2019.
