Our program typically treats patients with neurologic conditions such as:

- Parkinson's Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Neuropathy

Total number of patients treated with a neurological condition in 2019: 119

Average age of patients with a neurological condition treated in 2019: 68

Average length of stay for patients with a neurological condition treated on our Rehab Unit in 2019: 15 Days

Our program offers:

- Education and resources to promote lifestyle behaviors that promote wellness and longevity

Program facts

- 76% of our patients with neurological diagnosis in 2019, returned home once they have achieved their established goals.
- 14% of our patients with neurological diagnosis in 2019, were discharged to a skilled nursing facility.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with mobility, dressing, grooming, speech, language and mental skills.
- Our Rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating patients with a stroke as we serve more disabled and medically complex patients than those served in other facilities in the region and nation.
- It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 10% of our patients with a neurological diagnosis transfer back to the medical floor in 2019.
- The overall patient satisfaction for 2019 was in the top 10 percent of the nation. Our patient satisfaction for patients with neurological diagnosis was 93% in 2019.
