Inpatient Rehabilitation Fact Sheet 2019

Diagnosis: Orthopedic

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Our program typically treats patients with orthopedic conditions resulting from:

- Back or neck surgery
- Back or neck pain
- Hip or knee replacement
- Arthritis
- Fracture or trauma

Total number of patients with an orthopedic condition treated in 2019: 54

Average age of patients with an orthopedic condition treated in 2019: 67 years

Average length of stay for patients with an orthopedic condition treated on our Rehab Unit in 2019: 14 days

Program facts

- 78% of our patients with orthopedic diagnosis in 2019, returned home once they have achieved their established goals.
- 11% of our patients with orthopedic diagnosis in 2019, were discharged to a skilled nursing facility.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with mobility, dressing, grooming, speech, language and mental skills.
- Our rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating patients with an orthopedic condition as we serve more disabled medically complex patients than those served in other facilities in the region and nation.
- It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 11% of our patients with orthopedic diagnosis transferred to a medical floor in 2019.
- The overall patient satisfaction for 2019 was in the top 10 percent of the nation. Our patient satisfaction for patients with orthopedic diagnosis was 95% in 2019.
