SBP Assessment and Treatment Services

We provide specialized assessment and therapy services for children ages four to 14 who experience a range of PSB, including assessment to explore their level of functioning, the nature and extent of their PSBs, identify co-existing conditions, and determine treatment recommendations to increase safety and directly address and manage the PSBs. Caregivers are an important part of our services and their participation is vital.

Inclusion and Exclusion SBP Criteria

- A child or adolescent between the ages of 4 and 14 years old
- Parent or caregiver consistent attendance and active participation in treatment sessions
- If the child has current or ongoing criminal actions or criminal court proceedings, their admission for services will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis
- Child is adequately stable to participate in outpatient treatment and does not currently require higher level treatment services (Intensive outpatient program, psychiatric hospitalization)
- Child does not have moderate to severe autism spectrum, developmental disabilities, or intellectual disorder
- Child/Adolescent does not have severe or extreme SBPs at highest risk levels that require residential treatment services
- We do not provide forensic assessments to determine if abuse occurred or not
